Outreach and Support Officer

Job Description :

Under the supervision of the Executive Director, the Outreach and Support Worker is in charge of the project *Aider sans filtre: par les jeunes pour les jeunes*. The main objective of the project is to support the well-being of youth who are accompanying a loved one living with a mental health issue. It is designed to reach an audience of 12 to 29 year olds and is the first province-wide project that aims to meet these young people where they are.

Responsibilities:

- Facilitate awareness-raising activities in areas frequented by young people
- Offer support to young people who are close to people living with mental health issues
- Collaborate with the association's workers to develop intervention and psychosocial support approaches specific to youth
- Contribute to the creation of a network of young people who are on the lookout for other young people in their community who need support

Candidate Profile:

- Must be between the ages of 18 and 29 at the time of hiring, and bilingual
- Study or work experience in a field related to psychosocial intervention, or study or work experience in the field of communication, citizen mobilization or pedagogy
- Interest in working with youth (12-29 years old)
- Interpersonal skills, active listening skills
- Good understanding of the health and social services network specific to mental health (an asset)
- Experience in animation (an asset)
- Available evenings and weekends

Working conditions:

- Initial and ongoing training offered.
- Temporary position for a period of 4 years, full time or part time (25 to 35 hours)
- Hourly rate: 21\$ / hour
- Start as soon as possible
